Please try to attend. This is when we make the decisions about our club.

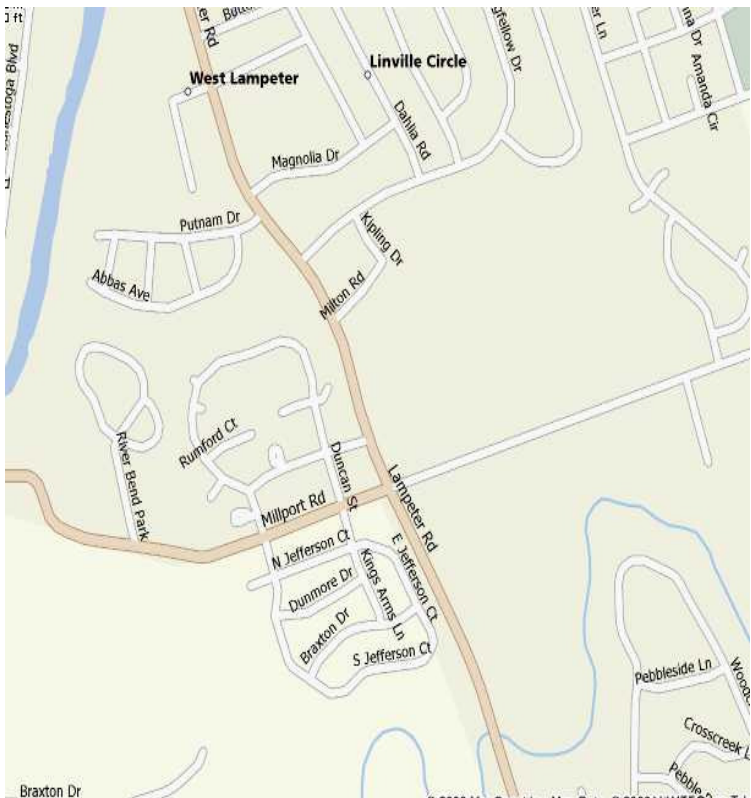
The February meeting will be held at 12 noon, Saturday February 7th, in the fellowship hall of Calvary Baptist Church, with an afternoon of indoor flying, including our "All Bull" championship. Please plan to be there, as this is where we need you to sign up for the Central Penn Flea market.

Calvary Baptist Church is located at 530 Milton Road, Lancaster, Pa. 17602 (for those with GPS). For the rest: From Bridgeport, follow Lampeter Road about 2 miles, Milton Road will be on the left (Look for signs for Calvary Baptist, or Lancaster Christian School). From Lampeter: Follow Lampeter road northwest toward Lancaster, after crossing Milport Road (Turkey Hill on corner), turn right onto Milton Road at the bottom of the hill.

After turning onto Milton Road, follow to the top of the hill, Lancaster Christian School will be on the right, Calvary Baptist Church will be on the left. As the road narrows, follow to the rear of the building and park at the lot. Follow the walkway back along the building and enter in the double metal doors (Watch for the sign).

Remember, this is where we need to sign up for the Central Penn event. Keeping this event running smoothly depends on your participation, with the setting-up, running and tearing down of the event.

Volunteers are needed to help set-up Friday, run the event Saturday and tear down afterwards on Saturday afternoon. For the newer members of the club, this is
