Your Lancaster club subscription is due for renewal, also your AMA subscription and insurance are about to expire.

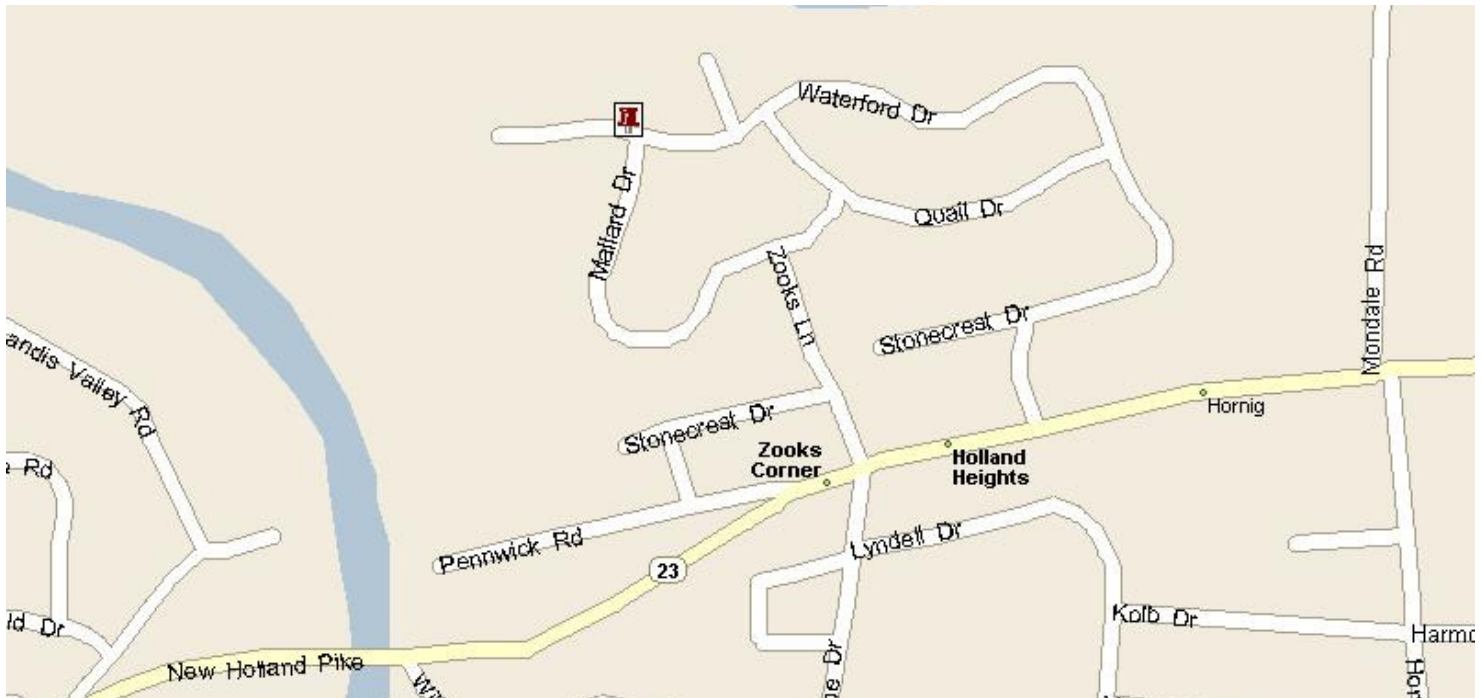

Minutes from LCRCC meeting 11/5/09

The minutes were accepted as posted

Guests and prospective members: Don Youngblood, Just getting into R/C, flew control line in years past.
Mark Fisher, new to R/C.

Treasurer report: Three of the four funds are down, which brought our net worth down about \$400. Bill Henry reminded us the \$6,000. from Central Penn is sitting in the checking account and needs to be put somewhere so it will collect interest. Julie wasn't present, and we need his suggestion as where to place the money. What came out of the discussion was, maybe we need to rethink where our funds are and do we need to make changes? If the market is up, then why are our funds down?

Central Penn: Still need a volunteer to replace Max. Jim will send out another email to seek a volunteer. Bill Henry informed us, the club has the same tables as we had earlier this year. That would be aisle K, Tables 5 and 6. Setup will be Friday March 12th, the show will be Saturday March 13th

Field Marshall: Field OK. Charlie wants to do a club clean up Saturday November 14th from 10am to 1 pm. Charlie will be bringing a trailer and we'll try to cleanup what is behind the clubhouse and do a general tidying.

Safety officer: No safety issues, although he expressed concern about the cold weather and batteries, especially LIPO's. Rick reminded us about keeping LIPO's warm before use and charging.

Ron Angle showed us his shirt for KIEF, which was made by the AMA, which was considerably cheaper. Ron will check the cost of the AMA making our shirts. He will report at the next (December) meeting.

Warren Wasiewski will host the December meeting and pizza in the basement of his house. Directions will be sent out prior to the meeting.

New Business: The February meeting will be held at the Locust Grove Mennonite School on Old Philadelphia Pike. There will be indoor flying available, also to pitch for Central Penn sign up.

Craig asked about suggestions for events for next year. Craig said we want to have an indoor fly twice a month from January through March. May have to schedule times for different planes because of issues that came up early this year while flying at Calvary's gym. Pilots to make a small donation to fly, so the club isn't paying for the gym. Guidelines will be published for flying.

Make-A-Wish date change? This years Make-A-Wish was brutal because of the heat. Tabled until next month.

This was emailed to me after the minutes were sent out. The decision was made to attach it to the end of the minutes and re-post them

Minutes are inaccurate in that:

No mention of the fact that I suggested we invest last years flea market money in the funds we now have. Much discussion ensued. I finally made a motion to that effect. It died due to a lack of a second. More discussion ensued and it was decided to table a decision till next meeting because Julie was not there and there were questions about the funds we now use. I also mentioned that our current policy, to review our funds for appropriateness and recommend new funds if needed. has not been followed. That should be done as soon as possible. The finance committee, consisting of Julie only, should make those recommendations as well as recommendations for changing funds and allocation within those funds as recommended.

I think it is also important to note, as I said at the meeting, that we have lost a considerable amount of money [in the neighborhood of \$1000 or more] by keeping the \$6000.00+ of the flea market funds in the checking account rather than investing it during the largest runup in the history of the market.

It is important that these facts be included in order to make the minutes a true reflection of what actually happened.
